Geocachers, you will have a chance to receive a special edition geocoin, produced specifically for this geotrail, by locating geocaches on the Adirondack Coast.

Rules:

- ⇒ Log onto goadirondack.com/geo to retrieve the coordinates and location information for the geocaches.
- ⇒ Geocaches are awarded points based on a ranking system of difficulty. Find enough caches to award you 100 points.
- ⇒ Once a Cache is found enter the date and code found in the cache onto the passport log sheet.
- ⇒ Bring in your passport to the address listed below once obtaining 100 points to receive the special edition coin.
